
PPWR Regulatory Information Declaration

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste

Product(s) concerned: The packaging and packaging products supplied by Deonet to the customer as at the date of issue of this declaration, including the sales, grouped and transport packaging of the promotional products supplied by Deonet.

Purpose of this declaration

Deonet hereby confirms that the packaging and packaging products concerned are assessed against the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR). On the basis of the information, technical documentation and evidence of conformity available as at the date of issue, no instances of non-conformity have been identified in respect of the PPWR requirements currently applicable to the packaging concerned, including, where relevant, Articles 5 to 12 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. This assessment remains subject to delegated acts, implementing acts, harmonised standards, guidance or other regulatory measures that may be adopted, amended or further clarified after the date of this declaration.

Nature of this declaration

This document is **not an EU Declaration of Conformity (DoC)** within the meaning of Article 39 and Annex VIII of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. It constitutes a regulatory information declaration issued by Deonet in support of its customers in their PPWR compliance activities. The official EU Declaration of Conformity remains, where applicable, a separate regulatory document to be drawn up by the economic operator responsible for it under the applicable legislation.

Basis of the assessment

This declaration is drawn up on the basis of the information available to Deonet as at the date of issue, including, where applicable:

- conformity documentation from suppliers;
- technical specifications;
- material declarations;
- product-related conformity information;
- test reports or conformity information from manufacturers;
- internal conformity assessments and controls;
- other relevant technical or regulatory information.

Supporting evidence is retained within Deonet's internal compliance documentation system.

Confidentiality of supporting documentation

Certain supporting documents may contain confidential commercial information, including supplier identities, formulations, technical specifications, test reports, production information and proprietary know-how. Consequently, detailed technical documentation, supplier documentation and source data are not systematically provided to customers.

Requests for additional technical documentation are assessed on a case-by-case basis, taking into account legal obligations, contractual arrangements, confidentiality requirements, intellectual property rights, commercial interests, the legitimate purpose of the request and the availability of the information requested.

Where justified in the context of compliance verifications, customer audits, contractual obligations or official inspections, relevant documentation may be made available subject to appropriate confidentiality conditions and within the limits of the applicable legal and commercial restrictions.

Roles and responsibilities under the PPWR

The PPWR assigns specific obligations to different economic operators, including manufacturers, importers, authorised representatives, distributors, fulfilment service providers and other relevant economic operators, depending on the actual circumstances within the supply chain. Responsibility for compliance therefore remains with each economic operator as defined in Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

This declaration is intended to support customers in their conformity assessment and does not replace their obligation to assess and comply with their own responsibilities under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 or any applicable national legislation, including extended producer responsibility (EPR) obligations and national registration and reporting obligations in the Member State where the packaging is first made available on the market.

Specific provisions for personalised or custom-made packaging

Deonet supplies promotional products and packaging that are personalised to a significant extent. Where packaging is supplied on the basis of customer-specific instructions, designs, dimensions, printing, configurations, compositions or other customer-requested modifications, the customer may, under the applicable legislation, be regarded in whole or in part as the manufacturer or as another responsible economic operator.

In such cases, this declaration relates solely to the information available to Deonet concerning the materials, components and packaging products supplied by Deonet. The customer remains responsible for:

- the assessment of its legal role within the supply chain;
- the performance of any required conformity assessments;
- the preparation of any required technical documentation;
- the drawing up of any required declarations of conformity;
- compliance with applicable registration, reporting and information obligations.

Deonet will, in so far as reasonably available and commercially appropriate, make available relevant technical information concerning the materials and components supplied by Deonet in order to support customers in fulfilling their own legal obligations.

Limitations of this declaration

This declaration relates solely to the packaging and packaging products supplied by Deonet to the customer as at the date of issue of this declaration and to the information available to Deonet as at that date.

This declaration does not constitute:

- legal advice;
- regulatory approval;
- certification;
- an independent conformity assessment;
- a guarantee of conformity.

Deonet does not assess how packaging and packaging products are combined, modified, printed, labelled, filled, assembled, integrated or otherwise used by the customer or by any third party within their own packaging systems, processes or supply chains.

Any final assessment of conformity for the specific use of a packaging product remains the responsibility of the customer or of any other responsible economic operator.

Validity

This declaration is issued in good faith on the basis of the information available as at the date of issue. It may be revised in the event of:

- changes to the product;
- changes in raw materials or composition;
- a change of supplier or production source;
- changes in the supply chain;
- the publication of new delegated acts, implementing acts, harmonised standards or other regulatory measures;
- new or updated technical or conformity information affecting the conformity status of the product.

Limitation of use and liability

This declaration is provided solely for information and compliance support purposes. It is based on the information available to Deonet as at the date of issue and does not constitute legal advice, regulatory approval, certification, an independent conformity assessment or a guarantee of conformity. Deonet cannot be held liable for conformity assessments, legal obligations, reporting obligations, declarations, registrations or other legal responsibilities which, under the applicable legislation, rest with the customer or with any other economic operator. Any assessment of conformity by the customer remains the sole responsibility of the customer and must take into account the intended use of the product, the specific configuration of the supply chain and all applicable legal requirements.
